

# FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION INVITES YOU TO A PURLIC MEETING

I-595 CORRIDOR RESURFACING PROJECT

I-595 and State Road 84 from I-75 to I-95

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Broward County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager. The presentation will start at 5:00 p.m. followed by a question-and-answer session. **PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Repave and restripe the existing roadway to extend the service life of the pavement and enhance safety for motorists.

#### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Repave the existing I-595 roadway corridor (which includes I-595 Express lanes, I-595 general purpose lanes, and State Road 84) to improve the resiliency of our infrastructure.
- Replace and upgrade signs and pavement markings to meet current standards and increase reflectivity.
- Create a smoother pavement surface to enhance safety.

#### **CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS**

- Work will be done in phases to reduce impacts to the community.
- No more than two lanes are anticipated to be closed at a time.
- Roadway resurfacing will be performed at night.
- Access to properties along the corridor will be maintained throughout construction.

## **CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION:**

- Anticipated Construction Start: April 2025
- Anticipated Construction End: March 2029
- Work will be done during off-peak periods over the next four years.
- Estimated Resurfacing Cost: \$20M

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
